

What is Transition to Work?

Transition to Work helps young people aged 15 -24 years develop the skills, behaviours and attitudes employers are looking for. Young people receive intensive individual support to improve their work readiness and can access a range of services including training, work experience, apprenticeships, and traineeships.
